general conditions of acceptance

- 1 all firearms /ammunition must be declared to the carrier and weapons must be unloaded.
- 1 firearms/ammunition can only be accepted for carriage as checked baggage that must be inaccessible to passengers during flight (unless a current caa exemption applies).
- 1 ammunition should not exceed 5kgs. in weight and must be securely boxed in accordance with the dangerous goods regulations (inside the container the cartridges must be protected against shock and secured against movement.)
- 1 loose ammunition will not be accepted and must not be placed in checked baggage.
